Background

The School Board, formerly known as the College Council, plays a crucial role in the affairs of the College. The School Board establishes the mission/vision of the College, plans, future directions and reviews all elements of the College plan.

The Como Secondary College School Board is an unincorporated body and has a representative membership made up of at least 5 elected parents (one of whom is a nominee of the P&C), 3 elected staff of the school, 1 community representative and the Principal.

The period of tenure for members elected is two years. That is, from March 18th 2019 to March 17th 2021.

There are three positions to be filled by parents. The election will take place from 5.30 pm in the Elicos Conference Room preceding the annual meeting at 5.45 pm on Monday March 18th 2019. Candidates will be invited to address the meeting for up to 2 minutes, before the commencement of a secret ballot. Parents must be present in order to vote.

Members of the public are invited to the annual meeting, as it is a forum in which to raise questions and issues concerning the College.
